Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the complaint(P-1) submitted by the petitioner. Further prayer is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect him as well as his family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Petitioner is the citizen of Australia. He is visiting India for a short while and is likely to stay here for another one month. There is property dispute between the father of the petitioner and his father's brothers. A civil litigation is going on between two of them. The petitioner apprehends that there would be danger to his life and liberty from his uncle-respondent No.4.

As of now there is no material placed on record to

indicate that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner that in case he apprehends threat to his life and liberty, it would be open for him to approach the official respondents, who will take action in accordance with law.
