The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to issue fitness certificate of Motor Vehicles to the petitioner without charging any amount towards the additional fee over and above the regular fee as provided notification dated 29.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) amending Rule 32 and Rule 81 of the Central Motor Vehicles (Twenty Second Amendment) Rules, 2016 and further prayer to direct respondent No.3, the Regional Transporter Authority, Patiala to issue fitness certificate of transport vehicle bearing no. PB23M4561 without charging any amount towards the additional fee over and above the regular fee during the pendency of this petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the issue involved in the present petition has already been

examined by this Court in CWP No. 21467 of 2021 decided on 08.03.2022.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State is not in a capacity to controvert the said order.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the order dated 08.03.2022 passed in CWP No. 21467 of 2021 titled '*Darshan Singh versus State of Punjab and others*'

The petition is disposed off.
