Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.291 dated 06.08.2021 registered under Sections 406/420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar Safidon, District Jind.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and was arrested on 23.10.2021. He further submitted that the investigation has been completed by the police. He further made prayer that petitioner who is not involved in any other case, be released on regular bail.

The present petition is contested by the State Counsel who submitted that at this stage as trial is yet to begin, the petitioner is not entitled to grant of regular bail.

I have considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties.

The case is triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class. The petitioner was arrested on 23.10.2021. Admittedly, the police has presented the challan in the Court, after the completion of investigation. The trial is yet to commence and it will take time for completion of trial. Other accused have already been granted bail, so no purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for any longer period.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned during the pendency of the trial.
