SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation and to direct the respondents No.3 & 4 and concerned police authorities not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner and her son and also not to harass them on the pretext to verify the whereabouts and details of younger son of petitioner namely Mohit, who is involved in many cases in different districts.

Reply dated 04.07.2022, by way of an affidavit of Mr. Ram Singh, HPS, DSP, Charkhi Dadri has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the specific stand taken by the respondents No.1 to 4/State that no such representation was ever received in the office of the official respondents, there was no occasion to consider and initiate any

action in such representation.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to move a fresh representation before the authority. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. However, in case, the petitioner moves any representation, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the same, within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of the said representation, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order.
