The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to register a case against respondent No.6 and also for impartial investigation in the matter.

In the present case, notice of motion was issued on 3.8.2017, pursuant thereto reply by way of affidavit of Gurjit Pal Singh, PPS, DSP (D), Hoshiarpur had already been filed. Learned State counsel refers to para 3 of the same, the relevant of which reads thus:

“During the investigation, it was found that Sarabjit Singh son of the petitioner alongwith his friends above said Jasmeen Kumar and Lucky set the shop of the petitioner on fire and Sarabjit Singh got burn injury in the said fire and the occurrence stated by above said Jasmeen Kumar and Lucky was found to be false in verification of alleged occurrence place stated by them.”

Learned State counsel further refers to Annexure P-7, which is the cancellation report also the aforesaid facts find mentioned and same has also been accepted by the trial Court on 16.10.2017. In view of the same,

learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and therefore, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the alternative remedy, if any, available under the law.
