[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 25.01.2021 in CWP No.155 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.155 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to decide the claim of the petitioner as reflected in legal notice dated 04.12.2020 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the payment, to release the same along with interest at the rate of 6.5% per annum from the date it fell due till its realization.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim made in legal notice dated 04.12.2020 has been decided in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated 25.01.2021 in CWP No.155 of 2021 and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
