This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for grant of emergency parole for four weeks to the petitioner to attend the Bhog ceremony of his father, which is to take place on 28.04.2022.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is the only son of the deceased, who has been convicted in FIR No.138 dated 26.05.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 506 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani, and sentenced to undergo R.I. for 10 years under Section 4 of POCSO Act. On the asking of the Court, it is further submitted that the petitioner has never taken any parole earlier.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.B.S.Virk, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Heard.

Bhog ceremony of father of the petitioner is tomorrow, i.e. 28.04.2022. The petitioner is stated to be the only son of the deceased. In the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court finds it appropriate that the petitioner be allowed to attend the Bhog ceremony of his father, which is fixed for tomorrow at Village Sisaye Kalirawan, Tehsil Hansi, District Hisar.

Hence, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to make the necessary arrangements to take the petitioner tomorrow, i.e. 28.04.2022, at Village Sisaye Kalirawan, Tehsil Hansi, District Hisar, at 9.00 a.m. in police custody for attending the Bhog ceremony of his father. The petitioner would be brought back on the same day, i.e. tomorrow at 6.00 p.m.

Learned State counsel would apprise the concerned authority of the order passed today.

Disposed of accordingly.
