Complaining willful violation of order passed in Civil Writ
Petition No.22715 of 2021 (Shama Rani vs. State of Punjab and others),
decided on 10.11.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under
Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part
of the order reads as under:-

*“In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides,
but without going into the merits of the controversy, this
writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent
no.3, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation
dated 21.09.2021 (P-6), in accordance with law by
passing speaking order, within a period of four months
from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.*

*It is made clear that in case, respondent no.3
is not the competent authority, the representation be
forwarded to the concerned quarter within one week of
receipt of certified copy for compliance of this order.”*

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Additional Advocate General, Haryana,
enters appearance for the respondents and submits that the necessary order
shall be passed within a week, from today.

In view thereof, no further order thereon is required to be
passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
