Reply by way of an affidavit dated 16.05.2022 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State based on reply submits that examination-in-chief of the complainant has been recorded and now the matter is fixed for 12.08.2022 for further examination of the complainant and other witnesses.

Considering the fact that this matter contains Section 498A as such in the larger interest of justice, it would be desirable that trial be concluded in a time bound manner.

Given above, learned trial Court is requested to conclude the trial by 30.09.2022. In case, the trial is not concluded within time as stipulated, it should be concluded not later than 30.11.2022.

The petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observation.

It is clarified that in case the accused seek adjournment that time shall be excluded from the aforesaid period.
