The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take action in pursuance of the FIR No.300 dated 13.9.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Arya Nagar, District Rohtak.

In pursuance of the order dated 03.5.2021 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Gorakh Pal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rohtak dated 23.7.2021. Para 3 of the said reply reads as under :-

“3. That during the course of investigation, notice under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. were issued against the above said accused but they have not joined the investigation. Further, the accused 1.

Harvinder Pal Singh s/o Kapoor Singh, 2. Kapoor Singh s/o Prem Singh and 3. Gurpreet Singh s/o Nishan Singh were arrested as per law on 16.5.2021, 21.5.2021 and 17.5.2021 respectively. The learned trial Court after considered the separate statement of the petitioner and her sister-in-law (Rajbala) in which they have no objection in granting the bail to the accused persons as matter has been compromised and they have received part payment from the accused has granted bail to accused Gurpreet and Harvinder on 17.5.2021. The accused Kapoor Singh due to his age (80 years) and COVID-19 factor has been released on his personal bond. After completion of investigation, police has prepared a final investigation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. which will be submitted before the learned Trial Court shortly.”

In view of the aforesaid development, the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the grouse of the petitioner has already been resolved.

Disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
