This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to hand over the investigation of FIR No.391 dated 24.11.2017 under Sections 458, 427, 342, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 30 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

In pursuance to the notice of motion order, status report by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala dated 08.08.2019, has been filed by learned State counsel, which is taken on record. A copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In Para 3 of the said report, it has been stated that three different complaints made by the petitioner were enquired into and first complaint dated 18.4.2018 was filed on 09.05.2018 and the other two complaints were also filed. It has further been stated in Para 6 that the cancellation report was submitted in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala and the

complainant made her statement dated 01.08.2019 before the Court of Ld. CJM, Barnala that she does not agree with the cancellation report and has also stated about the pendency of the present petition. The said Court on the request of learned counsel for the complainant adjourned the matter for filing protest petition.

In view of the above, the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue the matter there, if it has not been concluded as yet.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of.
