AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the writ petition, which this Court is unable to accept in the light of the pleadings in the writ petition. Having approached the Court with the pleadings, as have been so made in the writ petition and when the State has been called upon to respond, it cannot be permitted to be withdrawn at this stage. However, we are of the view that the withdrawal of the writ petition is being sought for the reason that the averments made in the writ petition appear to be not correct and are false and now facing a situation where the reply is likely to come depicting the position with regard to the falseness of the pleadings, the petitioner has approached the counsel for withdrawal of the writ petition. The same cannot be permitted.

The writ petition is dismissed with costs of ₹1,000/- to be paid by the petitioner and deposited with the High Court Lawyers' Welfare Fund.
