Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been working with the respondents as Sweeper for over 30 years, he is entitled to be considered for regularization in terms of the policy dated 08.08.2003 and 29.07.2022 (Annexures P-1 & P-2) respectively. He also contends that the services of his juniors have been regularized. He has drawn my attention to the legal notice dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) sent in this regard to the respondents and contends that the petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl.A.G., Haryana. accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
