Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.79, dated 8.4.2022, registered under Sections 376 (2)(f) and 506 IPC, at Police Station Jamalpur, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Status report by way of affidavit of Murad Jasvir Singh Gill, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-A, Ludhiana dated 5.9.2022 filed in Court is taken on record.

By virtue of the order dated 27.4.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Madan Lal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.4.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
