Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 13.10.2021 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sector 17, U.T. Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 28.04.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners are not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 28.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
