This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 3 dated 5.4.2022, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (as amended by (Amendment) Act, 2018) registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 28.4.2022, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI-Rajesh Kumar submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating, his voice sample is to be taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already volunteered to give voice sample.

As custody of the petitioner is not needed, the interim bail granted is made absolute, subject to petitioner's giving voice sample.

Disposed of accordingly.
