Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.4 dated 8.1.2022 registered under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149, 336, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no one sustained injuries at the time of the alleged occurrence and even otherwise, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in light of previous order dated 27.4.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh has not refuted the fact that none was injured at the time of the alleged occurrence and that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police. State counsel further submits that recoveries have already been effected in this case and now the petitioner is not required by the police for any further

Investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 27.4.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
