The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 19.02.2021 registered under Section 3(1), 4, 5(1)(a), 6(a) and 23 of the Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1984 and Section 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of order dated 13.05.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.05.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
