Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside the order dated 11.04.2022 (Annexure P-2) by the Divisional Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal – respondent No.3, wherein the prayer made by the petitioner for parole for admission of his children has been declined on the ground that there is an apprehension of breach of peace and possibility of the danger to the security, public order to the State.

Reply to the writ petition has been filed but there is no specific reasons assigned substantiating the contention with regard to the reason for rejection of the claim of the petitioner for release on parole. Merely stating that there is an apprehension of breach of peace and possibility of the danger to the security, public order to the State, would not be enough

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especially when there is no such assertion with regard to the substantiating of the same.

In the light of the above, we accept the prayer made in this writ petition for release of the petitioner on parole for two weeks from the date of his release. Petitioner shall be released to the satisfaction of the concerned authority with a direction to him to surrender before the jail authorities on 15th day of his release.
