SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner took admission in the B. Pharmacy Course. Certain additional subjects were introduced during the currency of the course and allegedly, the petitioner has failed to clear the said course as she could not pass the subjects introduced during the currency of the course.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that identically situated persons as the petitioner have been exempted from appearing in the additional subjects and thus, the petitioner has been discriminated against.

The argument cannot be accepted as there is nothing on record to substantiate the same.

Next, it has been contended that introduction of additional subjects during the currency of the course was illegal. Those additional subjects have since been withdrawn by notification issued by the University.

Withdrawal of the additional subjects subsequently does not make the initial introduction illegal. No illegality has been pointed out and thus, this argument also cannot be accepted.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
