Reply by way of affidavit of Vikas Kaushik, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, DLF, Gurugram on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR bearing No.286 dated 09.11.2021, under Sections 323/34/406/498-A/506 IPC, registered at Police Station DLF PH-III, Gurugram on the basis of memorandum of understanding dated 20.12.2021 (Annexure P-2).

As per the contents of the reply, the cancellation report has been submitted in the Court and the same has also been accepted.

The fact of submission and acceptance of cancellation report has not been disputed by both the learned counsel for the private parties. Furthermore, in terms of amicable settlement, a draft bearing No. 001963 drawn on HDFC Bank in the sum of Rs.20,00,000/- in the name of respondent No.2 and another draft

bearing No.001962 in the sum of Rs.45,23,832/- drawn on HDFC Bank in the name of Avyam Jain has been passed on to respondent No.2 today in the Court. Besides, the passport and LIC Policy of the minor child Avyam Jain have also been handed over to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that as the cancellation report has been accepted and as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
