The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order of dated 15.03.2022 posting the petitioner from the office of respondent No.3, i.e., Nathatop (J&K) to Bathinda (Punjab) at last leg posting; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anil Chawla, Sr. Panel Counsel for respondents-UOI, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has submitted that the UOI is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent-UIO is directed to take a conscious decision upon representation dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-3), within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

However, this order shall not be taken as order favouring the petitioner or respondents. The matter shall be considered by the authority independently.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
