Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 07.04.2022 passed by the learned Appellate Court, dismissing the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the order dated 25.09.2017 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh, vide which the petitioner-jvenile has been treated as an adult.

At the outset, learned Addl. PP UT Chandigarh, submits that the petitioner along with Kuldeep, Suraj and Vishal, were produced before the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh, in case bearing FIR No. 132 dated 04.08.2016 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-11, Chandigarh, and in view of the ossification test conducted on 27.06.2017 by the Board of Doctors, which depicts the bone age of the petitioner as 20-22 years and report dated 10.07.2017, the dental age of the petitioner-Rohit is 16-17 years, it was concluded that they are triable by the learned Children Court having jurisdiction and for this purpose they were directed to appear before the learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

The appeal preferred against the order dated 25.09.2017 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh, stands dismissed. However, the learned Appellate Court has drawn a conclusion that the appellant (petitioner) along with others has been facing trial regularly.

I have hearing the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

Since there is no infirmity in the orders dated 25.09.2017 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh and 07.04.2022 passed by the learned Appellate Court, this Court does not find any ground to allow the petition.
