1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.01.2022, in CRM-M-52690-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 20.01.2022, reveals that CRM-M-52690-2021, was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to take a decision on the representation dated 26.10.2021, submitted by the petitioner, within six weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply along with compliance report Annexure R-1/T dated 08.03.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 26.10.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be

08.03.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.1, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
