This is the petitioner's 7th attempt for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no.38 dated 07.08.2018 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 (added lateron) at Police Station Special Task Force-Phase IV, Mohali, District STF Wing, Punjab.

Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Hakam Singh, has informed the Bench that the prosecution has already concluded its evidence. The petitioner has already been convicted in three cases under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

In view thereof, no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
