Petitioners herein, *inter alia*, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* to quash the advertisement No.1/2021-22 (HWC-CP/672) dated 20.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) issued by the respondent-department.

2. Petitioners plead that while publishing Advertisement dated 20.03.2022 for the posts of Mid-Level Health providers-cum-Community Health Officers (MLHPs-cum-CHOs) on contract basis under National Health Mission (NHM) at 'Sub Center Level Health and Wellness Centers' in 18 districts of Haryana State, the qualification GNM and Pharmacist were not included.

3. Learned counsel further argues that advertisement is in violation Clause 11.4 of the National Health Policy, 2017. He submits that the petitioners have been deprived of their right of equality due to the inaction of the respondent-department. Qua their grievance, the petitioners submitted a representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-9), but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

4. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and states that competent authority shall take appropriate decision, either way, on the pending representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-9).

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners also agrees that let a final decision is taken by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-9), giving reasons thereof.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners as per representation dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) and take a decision, in accordance with law.

8. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

9. Disposed of accordingly.
