Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.90 dated 18.06.2021 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter to be referred as “the Act of 1985”) at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that other than FIR No.90, there are two more FIRs registered against the petitioner, the details of which are as under:-

- 1) FIR No.108 dated 10.08.2021 registered under Section 20 of the Act of 1985 at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.
- 2) FIR No.54 dated 18.04.2021 registered under Section 188 of the

Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after including the facts with respect to abovesaid FIRs and also after ascertaining the information as to whether the petitioner is on bail in the said cases or not.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
