Prayer in the present petition is for transfer of investigation in case FIR No.154 dated 29.04.2021, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala to an independent agency or by formulation of Special Investigation Team (SIT) outside District Patiala as the police of P.S. Patran District Patiala has conducted the FIR proceedings in a totally illegal and biased manner.

This Court vide order dated 27th April, 2022, directed the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to personally look into the investigation and file affidavit regarding upto date investigation.

In pursuance to the same, the affidavit has been filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala. It has been mentioned therein that the investigation is being conducted meticulously. It is submitted by the SSP that on 24th May, 2022, the DNA samples were deposited in FSL, Madhuban and the viscera of unidentified dead bodies was deposited with FSL, Hisar on 25th May, 2022. However, the reports are awaited. It has been stated in the affidavit that on receipt of the

said reports, the investigation would be completed in accordance with the law.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating authorities to seek said reports from the FSL concerned at the earliest and proceed with the investigation expeditiously in accordance with law. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his remedies as available to him under law.
