The petitioners have placed on record the copy of Aadhar

Cards (Annexure P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age. They have also placed on record Marriage Certificate as Annexure P-3 and photographs of marriage as Annexure P-4.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Incharge Police Post Daria, Near Railway Station, Chandigarh (U.T), that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
