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**HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)**

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.52 dated 16.03.2022, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur, under Sections 379 and 411 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no concern with the present case; that the petitioner has been indicted in the present case, on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused, namely, Amrik Singh (brother of the petitioner), who was arrested at the spot and that the recovery has already been effected from the co-accused.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the entire record.

Co-accused, namely, Amrik Singh (brother of the petitioner), in his disclosure statement has specifically stated that he used to commit theft of the motorcycles and then handed over the same to the petitioner, who further used to sell the same to different persons. Further, on his disclosure statement, three more motorcycles were recovered, out of

which two were duly identified by their owners, namely, Kulwinder Singh and Arun Kumar. It is beyond common parlance as to why petitioner's own brother will name him, of having being involved in the commission of the offence.

In view of the above, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
