HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.42 dated 08.02.2022, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 452 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Sadhaura, City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Vide order dated 29.04.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, submits that earlier, the petitioner joined investigation. However, vide order dated 12.09.2022, the petitioner was again directed to join investigation. In pursuance of the aforesaid order dated 12.09.2022, the

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petitioner has not joined investigation. He further submits that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation to know about the whereabouts of the co-accused.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, but without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court finds that no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars and, therefore, the order dated 29.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
