Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.40 dated 10.02.2011 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 473, 474, 411, 120-B IPC, Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh U.T.

As per allegations in the FIR the police received a secret information and one stolen car bearing fake number plate was recovered from the possession of petitioner and his accomplices on 10.02.2011. Thereafter, the petitioner was released on bail and subsequently he jumped bail was re-arrested on 26.02.2022 and is now facing trial. It will take time for conclusion of the trial. So no

purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any longer period.

In view of the matter, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petitioner is allowed and the petitioner is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned during the pendency of the trial.
