Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.63 dated 12.04.2022 under Sections 353/186/506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

Vide order dated 28.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.04.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.04.2022 is made

absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
