AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 157 dated 10.4.2022 under Section 63 of Copyright Act, 1957 and Sections 120-B, 420 and 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Rewari City.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner at the out-set submits that the petitioner was given a notice under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. which was not served upon him, rather was served on the family members, hence he could not appear. The contention is that the petitioner is willing to appear in compliance of the said notice.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice on instructions submits that let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer within seven days from today and in case the petitioner's custody is required, he would be given seven days notice.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the petition is disposed of.
