This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.4 dated 8.4.2022, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Range Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 30.5.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, he is required to join investigation again and to give his voice sample.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the interim anticipatory bail granted is made absolute, subject to petitioner joining the investigation as and when called for and on his giving the voice sample.
