Learned counsel for the petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 12.04.2022 wherein the Family Court, Fazilka has issued the conditional warrants to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the provisions of Section 125(3) Cr.P.C., there are no arrears towards the petitioner and hence, the conditional warrant issued by the Family Court are totally unsustainable in the eyes of law.
