Vide the instant petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.05 dated 08.02.2021, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, 1860, at Women Police Station, Patiala, Annexure P-1.

FIR, Annexure P-1, is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute. Petitioners are the parents-in-law of the complainant.

Vide order dated 07.05.2021, while issuing notice of motion, this Court directed the petitioners to join investigation and granted them interim anticipatory bail.

Upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery has been effected from them.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits, present petition is allowed and order dated 07.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
