The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in GD No.22 dated 27.09.2021 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1-T).
