The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 148 dated 20.06.2016 registered under Section 399/402 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at PS City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 27.04.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner had surrendered before the trial court on 02.05.2022 and had been admitted to interim bail. The aforesaid fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the present petition allowed and the interim order dated 27.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
