1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of Annexure P/1, dated 02.03.2022, in CWP-4020-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.03.2022, reveals that CWP-4020-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to take an appropriate decision on pending legal notice filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if respondent No.4 came to the conclusion that the petitioner was entitled to the amount claimed, the same be released to the petitioner within one month thereafter and in case the amount in question was not released within the aforesaid period of one month thereafter, the petitioner would be entitled to interest @ 6% per annum on the delayed payment thereafter till final realization of the amount.

3. Notice has not yet been issued. However, learned counsel for

the petitioner states that the respondents have released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.03.2022, in CWP-4015-2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.4, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
