1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 03.03.2022, in CWP-4047-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-4047-2022, was disposed of vide order dated 03.03.2022, by directing respondent No.4 to take appropriate decision on legal notice dated 31.01.2022, in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if on decision, it was found that the petitioner was entitled to the amount claimed, the same be paid to him forthwith within one month thereafter and in case the amount in question was not paid within the aforesaid period of one month, the petitioner would be entitled to interest @ 6% per annum on the delayed payment till final realization of the amount.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

4. However, reply has been filed along with Annexure R/1, releasing amount of Rs.2,71,783/-.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner confirms the petitioner having received payment as per entitlement and states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

6. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
