Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is working as a Salesman with the Markfed at a salary of ₹38,158/- has been fastened with a liability of ₹2,69,022/- on account of verification of the wrong bills of fuel vide order dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) while the trucks of the MARKFED had been driven extra kilometers. The appeal of the petitioner was filed on 28.02.2022. He submits that the in a similar petition bearing CWP-26467-2019 titled as **Kulwinder Singh vs. Board of Directors, The Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Ltd. and others**, wherein the petitioner was also a Salesman with the Markfed and recovery of ₹1,55,29,777/- has been directed against him and the revision petition was pending adjudication, the Coordinate Bench had directed the revisional authority to decide the petition within a period of three months. The Coordinate Bench had also directed that further recovery be stayed subject to the final order that may be passed by the revisional authority. He also

contends that the remedy of appeal has been provided in amended Rule 14 (i) of the Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Employees (Punishment & Appeal) Rules, 1990.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of without issuing notice to the respondents with a direction to the appellate authority (respondent No.1) to consider and decide the appeal (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the appellate authority.
