The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ to be issued in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to re-assign the petitioners duties as Home Guards considering the fact that there is no termination order passed by the respondent-department qua them.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would contend that the petitioners had been duly appointed and selected by the respondent-department as Home Guards and were performing their duties diligently. Keeping in view the good services rendered, their contract was renewed from time to time. However, for the reasons best known to the respondent-department, the petitioners were not allowed to perform their duties even though no termination order was passed. It is contended that the petitioners have approached the department by way of representation dated 08.03.2022 Annexure P-6 and legal notice dated 07.03.2022 Annexure P-7 which are still pending consideration.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation and legal notice of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

The instant petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 08.03.2022 Annexure P-6 and legal notice dated 07.03.2022 Annexure P-7 of the petitioners, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
