Complaining willful violation of order passed in Civil Writ
Petition No.19304 of 2020 (Jagan Nath Batra vs. State of Haryana and
others), decided on 06.12.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition
under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part
of the order reads as under:-

“We have been informed that now the entire
process including the scrutiny of applications, draw of
lots etc. would be conducted afresh and concluded within
a period of three months from today.

*Mr. Sabherwal would further clarify that such
process of reconsideration would be confined to the
applicants who had initially applied in response to the
public notice dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-9)*

*In view of the abvoe, noting survives for
adjudication in this bunch of writ petitions.*

The same are disposed of.

*The respondent-HSVP would remain bound by the
statementsuffered by Mr. Deepak Sabherwal and as
recorded hereinabvoe.*

Disposed of.”

Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate, enters appearance for the
respondent-HUDA and submits that the entire process including scrutiny of
the applications and draw of lots is in progress, which shall be completed
within a period of one month, from today.

In view thereof, no further order thereon is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
