Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.36 dated 02.04.2019, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 302 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 07.05.2022, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, trial Court was directed to admit him to interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.05.2022, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court which has granted him interim bail and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the above-said fact.

In view of the above, interim order dated 07.05.2022 is made absolute and the petitioner is directed to keep on appearing before the trial Court as per its directions.

Petition stands allowed.
