Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking direction of respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take necessary action on the complaint/representation dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner against respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Notice in this case was issued on 27.04.2022. Pursuant thereto reply dated 12.07.2022 by way of affidavit of Manavjit Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel makes reference to para 4 of the reply that the allegations levelled against respondent Nos.5 to 8 have been found to be false. The said para reads thus:-

“ That it is further reported that during the aforesaid enquiry proceedings, the petitioner suffered a statement before the enquiry officer that he did not want any action on his application (Annexure P-1) as his case is pending in the Hon'ble High Court regarding the matter mentioned in the application. It is further reported that the petitioner could not produce any witness, or strong evidence relating to the

*alleged incident of his abduction and illegal confinement by the private respondents as alleged by him in his application (Annexure P-1) and his version was found to be doubtful. It was further reported that it seems that the petitioner had concocted a story to save himself from the allegations of cheating on false inducement of recruitment on a job made by private respondent No.5 (Amarjit Singh). It was recommended that no action was required to be taken on the aforesaid application (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner and same should be consigned to the record room. The true translation of the detailed enquiry report dated 01.06.2022 is attached herewith for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court as **Annexure R-1/T.***

Learned State counsel submits that in view of the aforesaid present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared for the petitioner today and on the last date of hearing i.e. 12.07.2022 also none had appeared for the petitioner, the liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail alternate remedy as may be available to him.
