Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-24849-2021, titled as “Bhavpreet Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 07.12.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide representation dated 15.12.2020 (Annexure P12) by passing a speaking order, within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that on 27.04.2022, a speaking order, as directed by this Court has been passed and the copy thereof shall be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner within a period of week.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.
