Petitioner herein is seeking appointment on compassionate ground by contending that his father Shri Raj Kumar expired on 07.01.2020 while in active service with Haryana Police. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would rely upon Haryana Compassionate Assistance to Dependents of Deceased Employees Rules, 2003 in this regard.

Notice of motion

At this stage, Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and points out that Haryana Compassionate Assistance to Dependents of Deceased Employees Rules, 2003 have been amended from time to time and the latest rules as applicable would be Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019.

Faced with the situation, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to file representation with the Government seeking compassionate appointment under the amended rules and in case he does so, the same be decided expeditiously.

The instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner files a fresh representation within a period of two weeks from today, the same will be decided within a period of two months thereafter.
