MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.277 dated 02.07.2021 under Sections 188, 269, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 51 Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Section 3 Epidemic Act, 1897 registered at Police Station Adarsh Nagar Ballabgarh, Faridabad, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 28.04.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the entire case of the prosecution is based upon hearsay material, as no aggrieved person has lodged this FIR and the alleged forged document regarding COVID vaccination certificate was never put to use.

Notice of motion for 24.05.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance

of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Sunder Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 28.04.2022 is made absolute.
