This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.3 dated 31.3.2022, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and (Amended Act, 2018), registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Range Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 17.5.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to joining investigation.

Mr. Brahmeet Singh, Advocate appearing for complainant opposes the prayer for confirmation of interim anticipatory bail.
